

Student Dance Policies for Case, Horlick, and Park High Schools

It is understood that student dances are a privilege and not a right. To that end, these policies have been put into effect for the appropriate enjoyment for all attendees.

I. Homecoming, Winter Formal, and Other Non-Prom Dances Policies

1. Middle school students and anyone over the age of a 20 are not permitted to attend.
2. Inappropriate dancing is not permitted. Whatever an administrator deems inappropriate and/or indecent will not be permitted.
3. All attendees must have a picture ID to enter.
4. Appropriate dress is required. Whatever an administrator deems inappropriate and/or indecent will not be permitted.
5. Guest attendance is up to the discretion of the school administration. The appropriate approval form must be completed and on file in order for a guest to attend.
6. The following rules and requirements are in effect for the 3 weeks leading up to the day before the dance:
 - a. No school suspensions of any kind.
 - b. No unexcused absences (truancies).
 - c. No more than 3 hall sweeps (tardiness).

II. Prom Policies

Seniors

1. Must have a minimum of 18 credits by the end of the 1st semester of their Senior year.
2. The following rules and requirements are in effect from the start of the 4th quarter up to the day before the dance:
 - a. No school suspensions of any kind.
 - b. No unexcused absences (truancies).
 - c. No more than 3 hall sweeps (tardiness).
 - d. All fines and fees must be paid.
3. Inappropriate dancing is not permitted. Whatever an administrator deems inappropriate and/or indecent will not be permitted.
4. All attendees must have a picture ID to enter.
5. Appropriate dress is required. Whatever an administrator deems inappropriate and/or indecent will not be permitted.

Guests

1. All RUSD guest attendees are required to follow the same rules for student attendees as listed above.
2. Middle school students and anyone over the age of a 20 are not permitted to attend.
3. No student who has dropped out of school may attend.
4. Grade – Credit Requirement. By the end of the 1st semester:
 - a. Juniors must have a minimum of 12 credits.
 - b. Sophomores must have a minimum of 7 credits.
 - c. Freshman must have a minimum of 3 credits.
5. Guest attendance is up to the discretion of the school administration. The appropriate approval form must be completed and on file in order for a guest to attend.
